

NSW National Police Check Fact Sheet

A National Police Check is a Condition of Employment here at **Jamberoo Action Park**. It is a requirement that if you are successful in your application to work here and are <u>16 years and above</u> you must provide your valid National Police Check Certificate prior to commencing work.

Why Does Jamberoo Action Park require this?

Keeping children safe whilst they attend the park is a high priority of **Jamberoo Action Park.** One of the ways we can achieve this is by maintaining strong child safe policies and practices and ensure that they are updated and enforced at all times.

What is the National Police Check?

The National Police Checking Service provides an opportunity for Australian residents to apply for a National Police Certificate for paid employment, visa, adoption, some occupational licensing, student placements and for volunteers working in aged-care facilities inline with Commonwealth regulations.

You should allow a **minimum** of ten (10) business days for *name and date of birth* checks to be processed.

Jamberoo Action Park accepts National Police Checks provided by both the *Australian Federal Police* and *NSW Police*. Please consider both and choose one that most suites your needs.
